

2. Q: What is the Bible?
A: The Bible is God's message to people.
I Thessalonians 2:13.
3. Q: What does the Bible tell us?
A: "But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the son of God; and that believing ye might have life through His name."
4. Q: Who wrote the Bible?
A: God is the author but it was written by holy men of God as they were inspired by the Holy Spirit.

"For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man; but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost."
II Peter 1:21.
5. Q: How many different writers helped to write the Bible?
A: About 40 different writers.

6. Q: How many main divisions has the Bible?
A: **The Bible has two parts.**
7. Q: What is the first main division of the Bible called?
A: **The Old Testament.**
8. Q: What is the second main division of the Bible called?
A: **The New Testament.**
9. Q: What does the word testament mean?
A: **Testament means a will or an agreement between two people who promise to do something for each other.**
10. Q: How many books are included in the Bible?
A: **There are 66 books in the Bible.**
11. Q: How many books are found in the Old Testament?
A: **There are 39 books in the Old Testament.**
12. Q: How many books are found in the New Testament?
A: **There are 27 books in the New Testament.**
13. Q: Since the Bible contains so many books, is it really one book?
A: **Yes, the Bible contains 66 books written by 40 different men over a period of 2,000 years and forms one book.**
14. Q: Why is the Bible called "Holy"?
A: **It is called "Holy" because of its Divine Author, God, and its sacred purpose.**
15. Q: What is the one main teaching of the whole Bible?
A: **The one main teaching of the whole Bible is Jesus Christ as our Saviour.**
16. Q: Name all the books of the New Testament.
A: **Memorize from the list printed at the beginning of the Bible.**
17. Q: Since the Bible is so old, is it becoming out of date?
A: **No, the Bible is for people living today.**

18. Q: For whom was the Bible written?
A: **For everyone in the world.**
19. Q: Is the Bible a true book?
A: **Yes, the Bible is a true book. John 17:17 (b) "...thy Word is truth".**
20. Q: How long will the Bible stand?
A: **The Bible will stand forever.**
"The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: but the word of God shall stand forever." Isaiah 40:8.



Genesis 1:1.

45. Q: What person is introduced in the first verse of the Bible?

A: God, our Heavenly Father.

46. Q: Who is God?

A: God is the Creator and Ruler of all things.

47. Q: Where is God?

A: God is everywhere.

48. Q: What does God know?

A: God knows all things, even our thoughts.

"Thou knowest my downsitting and mine uprising, thou understandest my thoughts afar off." Psalms 139:2.

49. Q: What can God do?

A: God can do whatever He chooses to do.

"Behold, I am the Lord, the God of all flesh; is there anything too hard for me?" Jeremiah 32:27.

50. Q: How long has God lived?
A: **God has lived always, and will live forever.**
51. Q: Is God good?
A: **God is holy, just and good.**
"And the Lord passed by before him, and proclaimed. The Lord, The Lord God, merciful and gracious, long suffering, and abundant in goodness and truth." Exodus 34:6.
52. Q: Does God ever change?
A: **God is always the same. "For I am the Lord, I change not." Malachi 3:6.**
53. Q: Is there more than one God?
A: **There is but one living and true God.**

A: **God is a spirit and cannot be seen.**

58. Q: What is another name for God?
A: **Heavenly Father.**

59. Q: What word do we use to express the fact that these three persons: the Son and the Father, and the Holy Spirit, are one God?
A: **The Trinity.**
60. Q: How do we know what God is like?
A: **We know what He is like by reading the Bible and by Jesus' life on earth.**
61. Q: Who does God love?
A: **God loves everybody in the whole world, for "God is love."**
62. Q: How should we act toward God?
A: **We should honor and love God's name and be reverent in God's house.**
"Let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear." Hebrews 12:28.

CHAPTER 4

JESUS CHRIST

(Questions 65–98)

65. Question: Who is Jesus?

Answer: **Jesus is God's Son.**

"And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of God." Matthew 16:16.

66. Q: What did God do so people could have eternal life?

A: **"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life." John 3:16.**

67. Q: What did Jesus do so we could have forgiveness for our wrong doings?

A: **Jesus Christ, the Son of God, became man, lived, suffered, died and rose again from the dead to save sinners. John 3:16 (Should be quoted)**

68. Q: How did Jesus become like man?

A: **The Son of God, Jesus, became like man by being born and taking upon Him a human body.**

69. Q: Where was Jesus born?

A: **He was born in Bethlehem of Judea.**

70. Q: Who first told the good news of Jesus' birth?
A: **The angels of God told shepherds the good news of His birth.**
71. Q: Where was the baby Jesus first taken?
A: **He was taken to the temple in Jerusalem. He was presented to God.**
72. Q: How was Jesus' name chosen?
A: **It was chosen of God, His heavenly Father. "And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call His name Jesus for He shall save His people from their sins." Matthew 1:21.**
73. Q: When the angels spoke to the shepherds by what name was Jesus called?
A: **He was called Christ, the Lord.**
"For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, which is Christ the Lord." Luke 2:11.
74. Q: Who were Jesus' earthly parents?
A: **Mary and Joseph.**
75. Q: What does the name Christ mean?
A: **The name Christ means, "The Anointed One".**
76. Q: Where was Jesus taken when He was twelve years old?
A: **When twelve years old He was taken to the feast at Jerusalem.**
77. Q: What are we told about the boyhood of Jesus at Nazareth?
A: **"Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man." Luke 2:52.**
78. Q: How old was Jesus when He began His ministry?
A: **He began His ministry when He was about 30 years of age.**
79. Q: What event took place at the very beginning of Jesus' ministry?
A: **Jesus went to John the Baptist and was baptized by him in the River Jordan.**
80. Q: What was seen and heard that proved God was present when Jesus was baptized?
A: **The Holy Spirit came upon Him like a dove and a voice from heaven said, "This is my beloved son."**

81. Q: How did Jesus win over the tempter (Devil), in the wilderness?
A: **Jesus won over the tempter (the Devil) by speaking parts of the Bible.**
82. Q: What are some of the miracles that Jesus did?
A: **The blind received their sight, the lame walked, the lepers were cleansed, the deaf heard and the dead were raised up.**
83. Q: What greater work than miracles did Jesus do?
A: **He changed people and their way of living when He forgave them.**
84. Q: Can Jesus still change people's lives today? Why?
A: **Yes He can.**
"Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and forever." Hebrews 13:8.
85. Q: What twelve men did Jesus choose and train as His apostles and helpers?
A: **Jesus chose as His apostles and helpers: Simon Peter, Andrew, James, John, Phillip, Bartholomew, Thomas, Matthew, James the son of Alphaeus, Lebbaeus, Simon the Canaanite, and Judas. (Matthew 10:2-4).**
86. Q: What main events led up to and included Jesus' death?
A: **He was betrayed by Judas Iscariot, was falsely accused before the High Priest, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried.**
87. Q: Where was Jesus crucified?
A: **Jesus was crucified outside the gate of Jerusalem at a place called Calvary or Golgotha.**
88. Q: Why was it necessary that Jesus die on the cross?
A: **To take our punishment for the wrong things we have done.**
89. Q: By what power did Jesus rise from the dead?
A: **Jesus rose from the dead by the power of God through which He did His other mighty works.**
90. Q: What does the resurrection of Jesus prove to us?
A: **The resurrection of Jesus proves to us that He is the Son of God.**

91. Q: On what day of the week did Jesus rise from the dead?
- A: Jesus rose from the dead on the first day of the week, now called Sunday, or the Lord's day.
92. Q: How long did Jesus live on the earth after He arose?
- A: Jesus was seen by His disciples for 40 days after He arose from the dead.
93. Q: What was the great commission that Jesus gave to His disciples?
- A: Jesus said, "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost." Matthew 28:19.
94. Q: What did Jesus tell His disciples they were to be?
- A: They were to be His witnesses.
- "But ye shall receive power after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem and in all Judea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth." Acts 1:8.
95. Q: What was the last command that Jesus gave His disciples?
- A: Jesus said, "Wait for the promise of the Father, which saith He, ye have heard of Me. For John truly baptized with water but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost." Acts 1:4-5.
96. Q: Does Jesus still live and reign today?
- A: Jesus lives, and reigns at the right hand of God.
- "It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us." Romans 8:34.
97. Q: What great truths about Jesus Christ as the Saviour of men can you read in the Bible?
- A: That all men need to have their sins forgiven; that Jesus Christ died for all people; that eternal life is the gift of God when we believe in Jesus.
98. Q: Is Jesus able to save anyone?
- A: Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them. Hebrews 7:25.

CHAPTER 5

THE PLAN OF SALVATION

(Questions 1–25)

1. Question: What promise was given to Adam and Eve before they were sent out of the Garden of Eden?

Answer: They were given the promise that Jesus Christ would come and bring Salvation.

2. Q: What does the word "Redemption" mean?

A: Redemption means to deliver or rescue by paying a price.

"Who (Christ) gave himself for us, that He might redeem us from all iniquity, . . ." Titus 2:14a.

3. Q: Who is the one that forgives the sinner?

A: The only redeemer of sinners who is our Lord Jesus Christ.

"Neither is there salvation in any other; for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved" Acts 4:12.

4. Q: When was our redemption planned?

A: Before Adam and Eve were created God knew that they would disobey Him. He planned ahead of time to give His only Son, Jesus.

"Who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began" II Timothy 1:9.

5. Q: How did God make it possible for us to have eternal life?

A: "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him, should not perish but have everlasting life." John 3:16.

6. Q: What did God do with the sins of the people?

A: He permitted Jesus to take the punishment for the people's sins.

"All we like sheep have gone astray: we have turned everyone to his own way; and the Lord hath laid on him the iniquity (sin) of us all." Isaiah 53:6.

7. Q: What did Jesus do to take away our sins?

A: He died on the cross and there He was punished for our sins.

". . .while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." Romans 5:8.

8. Q: Did Jesus take the punishment for everyone's sins?

A: Yes. ". . .not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world." I John 2:2.

9. Q: Why have not all people taken Jesus Christ as their Saviour?

A: Because some have never heard about Him and others have not believed on Him.

"How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher?" Romans 10:14.

10. Q: What does salvation mean?

A: Salvation means to be saved from guilt and the punishment of sin by taking Jesus Christ as Saviour.

11. Q: Do we become a Christian by the good things we do?

A: No, we cannot become saved by doing good things.

"For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God." Ephesians 2:8.

12. Q: Can we earn our way to heaven?

A: No, eternal life is a gift given by God.

"For the wages of sin is death (separation from God), but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." Romans 6:23.


13. Q: If we are born into a Christian family or join the church, does this make us a Christian?
- A: **No, everyone must personally take Jesus Christ as his own Saviour and Lord.**
14. Q: How do we take Jesus Christ as our Lord and Saviour?
- A: **"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation." Romans 10:9, 10.**
15. Q: What is repentance?
- A: **Repentance is asking God for the forgiveness of our sins; telling God we are sorry for the wrong things done; and accepting Jesus Christ as our Saviour.**
16. Q: Is repentance necessary before becoming a Christian?
- A: **Yes. The Bible says: "Except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish." Luke 13:3.**
17. Q: What is faith in Jesus Christ?
- A: **Faith in Jesus Christ means that I believe in Him as God's Son and that I can trust Him to forgive me and become my own Saviour and friend.**
18. Q: What do we mean by the word "conversion"?
- A: **The word "conversion" means to change your way of living, your talk, your acts.**
19. Q: What is a born-again Christian?
- A: **A born-again Christian is one who has been born into God's family after accepting Jesus Christ as their personal Saviour.**
- "Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God." John 3:3.**
20. Q: What does it mean to be born again?
- A: **It means a person is born spiritually into the family of God by taking Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord. It is then we are called born-again Christians.**
21. Q: Is it necessary to be born again to get to heaven?
- A: **Yes, the Bible says, "Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God." John 3:3.**

22. Q: How are we born again?
- A: **(A) By confessing our sins.
(B) By feeling sorry for our sins.
(C) By receiving forgiveness for sin.**
23. Q: What happens when we are born again?
- A: **The Bible says, "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away: behold, all things are become new." II Corinthians 5:17.**
24. Q: What is the first thing that Jesus wants us to do when we are born again?
- A: **He wants us to tell others about Him and tell them how they too can become a Christian.**
25. Q: How do we show others that we are Christians?
- A: **By testifying of our faith in Him and our love for Him and by living a life that is pleasing to Him.**
- "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven." Matthew 5:16.**

CHAPTER 6

THE HOLY SPIRIT

(Questions 26–54)

26. Question: Who is the Holy Spirit?
- Answer: He is the third person of the Trinity, God the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit.
27. Q: What are some of the divine names given to the Holy Spirit?
- A: He is called the "Spirit of grace, of truth, of life and of promise." He is also called "The Comforter."
28. Q: What does the word "Comforter" mean?
- A: The word Comforter comes from a Greek word which means "one called along side to help."
29. Q: How does the Holy Spirit help us to become a Christian?
- A: The Holy Spirit shows us our sins and helps us to feel our need for Jesus who died on the Cross.
30. Q: What does the Holy Spirit do for us when we read God's Word, the Bible?
- A: He teaches us and helps us understand God's truth.

31. Q: Does the Holy Spirit help us remember what we have learned from the Bible?
- A: Yes. John 14:22 says, "He shall bring all things to your remembrance.
32. Q: When does the Holy Spirit help us?
- A: He helps us when we witness, pray, serve and when we are tempted and in trouble.
33. Q: Does the Holy Spirit help Christians to tell others about Jesus Christ?
- A: The Holy Spirit will give us courage (power) to tell (or witness to) others.
34. Q: How should we treat the Holy Spirit?
- A: We should treat the Holy Spirit with respect and love. "And grieve not The Holy Spirit of God . . ." Ephesians 4:30a.
35. Q: When was Christ's promise of the Holy Spirit fulfilled?
- A: On the day of Pentecost.
36. Q: What did Jesus say to His disciples about the Holy Spirit just before He ascended?
- A: "But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth." Acts 1:8.
37. Q: What is the baptism with the Holy Spirit?
- A: It is the promise and the gift of the Heavenly Father and His Son.
38. Q: Is there only one baptism with the Holy Spirit?
- A: There is one baptism, but many refillings with the Spirit.
39. Q: Who baptizes with the Holy Spirit?
- A: Jesus baptizes (fills) with the Holy Spirit. Luke 3:16.
40. Q: Is the baptism with the Holy Spirit for every Christian?
- A: Yes. "For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off . . ." Acts 2:39.

41. Q: What is the first sign proof when a person is baptized (filled) with the Holy Spirit?
- A: He speaks in an unknown language as the Holy Spirit gives him the words. Acts 2:4 says, "And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance."
42. Q: To whom are we talking when we speak or pray in a language unknown to us?
- A: I Corinthians 14:2 says, "For he that speaketh in an unknown tongue speaks not unto men, but unto God."
43. Q: What is the greatest promise of power in the New Testament to believers?
- A: Acts 1:8.
44. Q: Name the gifts of the Spirit according to I Corinthians 12.
- A: Wisdom Healings Prophecy
Knowledge Miracles Tongues
Discernment Faith Interpretation
45. Q: How can we divide the gifts of the Spirit into groups?
- A: There are three groups: 1. The gifts of insight (wisdom, knowledge, understanding)
2. The gifts of power (for service)
3. The gifts of utterance (speaking)
46. Q: How can we receive the gifts of the Spirit?
- A: We can trust God to give us the gifts that will help us do what He wants us to do.
47. Q: Why are the gifts of the Spirit given?
- A: For the good and benefit of the children of God (believers).
48. Q: Should we desire the gifts of the Spirit?
- A: The scripture tells us to "covet" (desire) earnestly the best gifts. "But covet earnestly the best gifts . . ." I Corinthians 12:31.

49. Q: What is the "Fruit of the Spirit"?
- A: **The Fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, temperance, gentleness, goodness, meekness, faith. Galatians 5:22.**
50. Q: How will you bring forth the fruit of the Holy Spirit?
- A: **By living a Christian life and being obedient to Jesus Christ.**
51. Q: When someone speaks a message to the church in an unknown tongue, how can people understand the meaning of that message?
- A: **The Holy Spirit helps him or someone else interpret the message for everyone present.**
52. Q: What does a message given in an unknown tongue do for people when it is interpreted?
- A: **Christians are encouraged, comforted, and helped to grow in the Lord.**
53. Q: How does speaking in an unknown tongue help a person after he has been baptized with the Holy Spirit?
- A: **A person grows closer to God and helps himself to grow spiritually.**
54. Q: How does a person know when he is baptized with the Holy Spirit?
- A: **He speaks in an unknown tongue.**

EVANGELISM

(Questions 55–68)

55. Question: What does the word "Evangelism" mean?

Answer: Evangelism means to preach or tell the story about Jesus Christ.

56. Q: What does the word "gospel" mean?

A: Gospel means good news or glad tidings of salvation through Jesus Christ.

57. Q: How does the Church evangelize (tell others about Jesus Christ)?

A: By Christians telling non-Christian people about the Lord Jesus Christ.

58. Q: Where are we to evangelize (tell others about Jesus Christ)?

A: We are to share and tell the story about Jesus everywhere throughout the whole world. Mark 16:15 tells us to go into the world and tell about Jesus.

59. Q: Why is it necessary and important to evangelize?

A: Because people cannot become Christians unless they know about Christ and how to belong to God's family. "How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher." Romans 10:14.

60. Q: Is there any reason why we should evangelize?

A: Yes, because Jesus told us to do so. "And ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem and in all Judea, and in Samaria and unto the uttermost part of the earth. Acts 1:8.

61. Q: What is one of the best ways to evangelize?

A: One of the best ways is to talk to people about Jesus Christ and show them how they can belong to God's family.

62. Q: What is personal soul winning?

A: Personal soul winning is to tell a person about Jesus Christ and to show him how to become a Christian.

63. Q: How do you lead someone to Jesus Christ?

A: You lead a person to Christ by showing him in the Bible that Jesus loves him and show him why he needs Jesus as personal Saviour, and by telling him he must accept Christ as Saviour.

64. Q: What will show the non-Christian person that he needs Jesus Christ as his own Saviour?

A: The Bible which is God's Word.

"And that from a child thou hast known the holy Scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus." II Timothy 3:15.

65. Q: Can anyone help someone else to become a Christian?

A: Yes, everyone who first has accepted Christ as his own Saviour and lives from Him each day.

66. Q: Is it the responsibility of every Christian to tell other people about Jesus Christ?

A: Yes, every Christian is responsible to see that people around the world hear the story of Jesus Christ and what He has done for us.

67. Q: Where may we tell others about Jesus?

A: Everywhere, home, school, play, work, church or any place we meet non-Christian people.

68. Q: What does Proverbs 11:30 say about people who win people to Christ?

A: Proverbs 11:30b ...he that winneth souls is wise.

CHAPTER 8

THE SACRAMENTS

(Questions 69–85)

69. Question: What is a Sacrament?

Answer: A sacrament is a sacred performance or observance appointed by Christ. It is an outward sign of an inward work.

70. Q: How many sacraments are there?

A: There are two sacraments. Water baptism and the communion.

71. Q: What is the outward sign in water baptism?

A: It is being put under water in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost.

“Goye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost.” Matthew 28:19.

72. Q: By whom and where was Jesus baptized?

A: By John the Baptist in the River Jordan. Mark 1:9.

73. Q: Is it important to be baptized in water?

A: Yes—when we are baptized in water, our past life is buried and we live a new life because we are a child of God.

74. Q: Who should be baptized in water?

A: Those who have become a Christian and belong to God's family.

75. Q: Who conducts the baptismal service?
 A: **The pastor, evangelist, or any minister of the Gospel.**
76. Q: What does the word "communion" mean?
 A: **It is a sacrament where you partake of bread and the juice.**
77. Q: What does the bread, served at communion, represent?
 A: **The bread represents Christ's body which was broken for us when He died on the cross.**
78. Q: What does the juice, served during communion, represent?
 A: **The juice represents the blood of Jesus Christ which was shed when He died on the cross.**
79. Q: What is another name for communion?
 A: **Communion is also known as "The Lord's Supper."**
80. Q: What is the spiritual meaning of the Lord's supper?
 A: **The Lord's Supper is a loving and grateful way of remembering our Saviour's death, and a time when we take time to especially thank Him for what His dying did for us.**
81. Q: What is the purpose of the Lord's supper?
 A: **To remember the Lord's death til He comes back to earth again.**
"For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do show the Lord's death till he come." I Corinthians 11:26.
82. Q: In what way are we helped when we take communion?
 A: **We become stronger Christians and we remember the Lord's death and thank Him for what He has done for us.**
83. Q: How should we prepare before taking communion?
 A: **We should ask for forgiveness. We should show reverence. We should thank and praise Him for dying on the cross for our sins.**
84. Q: Who should take communion?
 A: **All who know Jesus Christ as their Saviour and are living a life that is pleasing to Him.**
85. Q: Should all Christians take communion?
 A: **They should, for Jesus has given us a command in Luke 22:19, "This do in Remembrance of me."**

CHAPTER 9

DIVINE HEALING

(Questions 1–16)

1. Question: What is Divine Healing?

Answer: It is the cure of physical sicknesses by the direct power of God. "The prayer of faith shall save the sick and the Lord shall raise him up." James 5:15.

2. Q: How is Divine Healing received?

A: As a result of faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, the Great Physician. James 5:15.

3. Q: Where is the Old Testament covenant of healing?

A: It is found in Exodus 15:26. "I am the Lord that healeth thee."

4. Q: Did the Psalmist David praise and thank God for his blessing of healing?

A: Yes. "Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: Who forgiveth all thine iniquities, who healeth all thy diseases." Psalm 103:3.

5. Q: In James 5, verse 14, what was used to anoint people who were prayed for?

A: Oil was used.

6. Q: Who took our sicknesses according to Matthew 8:17?

A: Jesus. "...Himself took our infirmities (diseases), and bare our sicknesses." Matthew 8:17.

7. Q: Why does Jesus heal the sick?

A: Jesus heals the sick:
 – to show His power to heal.
 – because He loves us and has compassion for us.
 – that God might be glorified.

8. Q: Did Jesus heal people while He was on earth?

A: Yes, He healed many people. "And Jesus went about all the cities and villages - healing every sickness and every disease among the people." Matthew 9:35.

9. Q: Does Jesus heal sick people today?

A: Yes, because Hebrews 13:8 tells us that "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever."

10. Q: Of what was Paul healed on the Island of Malta?

A: According to Acts 28:5 - Paul was healed of the viper's bite.

11. Q: What caused sickness and disease to come upon people?

A: Sickness and disease came upon man because Adam disobeyed God when sin entered the world.

12. Q: Is sickness and disease of God or of Satan?

A: Sickness is of Satan and not of God.

13. Q: Who can we call to pray for us when we are sick?

A: "Is any sick among you? Let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord." James 5:14.

14. Q: What has the Lord promised to do when we pray and believe for healing?

A: He has promised to heal. "And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up." James 5:15.

15. Q: What is a miracle?

A: A miracle is a supernatural work of God.

16. Q: After we are healed what must we do?

A: Give all the praise and glory to Jesus and serve Him faithfully. (We should be sure to praise and thank Jesus for making our bodies well again.) "And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking and leaping, and praising God." Acts 3:8.

22. Q: What is spiritual growth?
- A: **Spiritual growth is growing to become a strong and faithful Christian.**
23. Q: What kind of food do Christians need for spiritual growth?
- A: **Spiritual food. "Man doth not live by bread only, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of the Lord doth man live." Deuteronomy 8:3.**
24. Q: What is our spiritual food?
- A: **The Word of God, the Bible. "I have esteemed (hid) the words of His (God's) mouth (spiritual food) more than my necessary food." Job 23:12.**
25. Q: Why do we need spiritual food?
- A: **So that our spiritual life may be nourished and strengthened. "They that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength" Isaiah 40:31.**
26. Q: How often should we read the Word of God, the Bible?
- A: **Daily.**
27. Q: Why is it important to read the Bible daily?
- A: **So that we may keep from sinning. "Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee." Psalm 119:11.**
28. Q: What does the word "prayer" mean?
- A: **Prayer is talking to God.**
29. Q: Why is it important to pray?
- A: **Because talking to God brings us closer to Him and because we like to tell Him we love Him and ask for things we need from Him.**
30. Q: Does the Bible tell us to pray?
- A: **Yes. "Men ought always to pray." Luke 18:1.**
31. Q: How should we come to God in prayer?
- A: **We should pray in the name of Jesus.**

"Verily, verily, ...I (Jesus) say unto you, whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in My Name, He will give it you." John 16:23.

32. Q: How should we pray?
- A: **We should pray with faith or a firm trust that for Jesus' sake our prayer will be answered.**
- "And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive." Matthew 21:22.**
33. Q: What is the model prayer given by Jesus?
- A: **The Lord's Prayer -- Matthew 6:9-13 (Memorize).**
34. Q: Does God answer all prayers?
- A: **God answers every prayer, not always as we desire but in the way that is best for us.**
35. Q: What does the word "tempted" mean?
- A: **The word tempted means to feel like doing wrong when you should not.**
36. Q: Who tempted Jesus?
- A: **"And He was there in the wilderness forty days, tempted of Satan." Mark 1:13.**
37. Q: Who tempts us and tries to make us do wrong?
- A: **Satan, the Devil.**
38. Q: When does temptation become sin?
- A: **When we do the wrong thing we are tempted to do.**
39. Q: How can we win over temptations?
- A: **By knowing God's Word, and by praying to God and asking for His help.**
40. Q: What should we do when we sin and disobey God?
- A: **We should confess our sins to God, our heavenly Father.**
41. Q: What Bible verse tells us that God will forgive us from sin?
- A: **I John 1:9 "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."**



CHAPTER 11

SECOND COMING OF CHRIST

(Questions 42-62)

42. Question: What does the Second Coming of Christ mean?

Answer: It means the personal, visible, and bodily return of the Lord Jesus Christ to the earth. "Which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven." Acts 1:11.

43. Q: What are the two phases of the Second Coming?

A: First, His rapture of the Church. "For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord." I Thessalonians 4:16, 17.

Second, His return to earth with the Church. "...Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints." Jude 14.

44. Q: What is the purpose of Jesus' return to earth?

A: To set up His Kingdom.

45. Q: When did Jesus Christ come to earth the first time?

A: When He was born as a babe in the town of Bethlehem.

46. Q: How many times is the Second Coming of Christ mentioned in the Bible?

A: It is mentioned 318 times in 216 chapters.

47. Q: What Old Testament prophets told of the Second Coming of Christ?
A: **Isaiah, Jeremiah and Daniel.**
48. Q: Did Jesus say He would come again?
A: **Yes, He said, "I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself" John 14:2-3.**
49. Q: Where will we meet the Lord when He returns?
A: **We will meet the Lord in the air. 1 Thessalonians 4:17.**
50. Q: When will Jesus come back to earth?
A: **Matthew 24:36 tells us, "But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only."**
51. Q: For whom will Christ come?
A: **He will come for all those who are watching and waiting for His appearing.**
52. Q: Will Christ come for only those who are living?
A: **No. Christ is coming for all, both living and dead, who know Christ as their Saviour.**
53. Q: What happens after we meet Christ in the air?
A: **We will be rewarded for our service.**
54. Q: What happens on the earth after Christ takes away the Christians?
A: **The great tribulation takes place.**
55. Q: What is the tribulation?
A: **The tribulation is a time of sadness and suffering.**
56. Q: How will the tribulation end?
A: **It will end when Jesus Christ comes with the Christians and the defeat of anti-Christ.**
57. Q: What will Christ do after the tribulation period ends?
A: **He will set up His Kingdom and reign for 1,000 years.**
58. Q: What do we call the period of 1,000 years when Jesus reigns with His people?
A: **The Millennium.**

59. Q: Describe the Anti-Christ.
A: **A person who says he is the Lord Jesus Christ but is really not the Christ that we know. He is one that will be against Christ.**
60. Q: When will the Anti-Christ be destroyed?
A: **During the Battle of Armageddon.**
61. Q: Who are the dead in Christ?
A: **Born-again Christians who died before the return of Jesus Christ.**
62. Q: What can we do to make sure we are always ready for Christ's return?
A: **Live the Christian life every single moment.**



 C. Jesus Christ, the Baptizer.
 D. Jesus Christ, the coming King.**
72. Q: Who is the head of the church?
 A: **The Lord Jesus Christ.**
 ".....and gave Him to be the head over all things to the church, which is His body." Ephesians 1:22-23.
73. Q: For what special reason did Jesus Christ want churches on this earth?
 A: **So people could hear about Jesus Christ and then accept Him as their personal Saviour.**
74. Q: Why should those who believe in Jesus Christ unite with a church?
 A: **In order to honor Christ, to provide for their spiritual life and growth and to work for the upbuilding of the Kingdom of God.**
 "And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching." Hebrews 10:24-25.
75. Q: What are the requirements for membership in the Foursquare church?
 A: **To know Jesus Christ as personal Saviour and Lord and to manifest a desire to live a christian life.**
76. Q: What are the duties of Foursquare church members?
 A: **To attend its services, contribute to its support and share in all activities.**
77. Q: What does it mean to worship God?
 A: **It means to love, honor, magnify and reverence Him.**
 "I will praise the Lord with my whole heart, in the assembly of the upright, and in the congregation." Psalm 111:1.

78. Q: What did Jesus teach about worship?
 A: **Jesus taught that "God is a spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth." John 4:24.**
79. Q: How should we act in church?
 A: **We should be reverent and respectful.**
 "These things write I unto thee.....that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God." I Timothy 3:14-15.
80. Q: Why do we set aside one day each week as a day of worship?
 A: **Because God set aside one day in seven---the Sabbath---or the Lord's Day as a day for rest and worship.**

CHAPTER 15

HELL

(Questions 12–25)

12. Question: What do we mean by Hell?

Answer: It is a place of punishment for those who do not accept Jesus Christ as Savior.

13. Q: For whom was Hell prepared?

A: It was prepared for the Devil and his angels. "Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels." Matthew 25:41.

14. Q: Why will people go to Hell?

A: They are sinners and have not accepted Christ as their Saviour.

15. Q: How long will the sinner be punished?

A: For ever and ever. "Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power." II Thessalonians 1:9.

16. Q: Should sinners be warned of Hell?

A: Yes. They should be told how they can escape hell and go to heaven.

17. Q: Does God feel happy about people (sinners) going to hell?

A: No – II Peter 3:9 tells us that He is longsuffering and is "not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance."

18. Q: Will there be another opportunity for people to accept Christ after they die?

A: No, because after a person dies, he is judged for his works and whoever is not found written in the Book of Life will be sent to Hell.

19. Q: What story did Jesus use to explain hell?

A: The story of Lazarus and the rich man found in Luke 16:22–31.

20. Q: Did the rich man remember after he died?

A: Yes, the rich man remembered his life on earth and cried to Abraham.

21. Q: Will people know they are in hell?

A: Yes, they will know and feel the torment of Hell. "And he (the rich man) cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame" Luke 16:24.

22. Q: How does the Bible describe Hell?

A: As a furnace of fire in Matthew 13:42; as a place of outer darkness; as a place where there will be weeping and wailing and gnashing of teeth in Matthew 22:13.

23. Q: Where will the unbelievers (non-Christians) be sent after they are judged for their deeds?

A: To the lake of fire which is Hell. "But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolators, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone; which is the second death." Revelations 21:8.

24. Q: What must people do to escape the punishment of hell?

A: Believe and be saved. Acts 16:31, "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and thou shalt be saved."

25. Q: What is another word for hell?

A: Hades – which is a place of torment.



34. Q: Why are not Christians judged at the Great White Throne Judgment?
 A: **Because their sin was forgiven when they accepted Jesus as their Saviour and asked God's forgiveness.**
35. Q: How can the sinner (non-Christian) escape the Final Judgment?
 A: **By accepting Jesus Christ now as his or her personal Saviour and living the Christian Life.**
36. Q: When will Christians be judged?
 A: **After Jesus Christ comes back to earth and takes the Christians with Him.**
37. Q: Why will Christians be judged?
 A: **So they can be rewarded for their works.**
 "For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that everyone may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad." II Corinthians 5:10.
38. Q: What are some of the awards that Christians may receive? (Name at least three).
 A: **The Crown of Life – James 1:12.**
The Crown of Glory – I Peter 5:2–4.
The Crown of Righteousness – I Thessalonians 2:19–20.
The Crown Incorruptible – I Corinthians 9:25–27.



CHAPTER 17

TITHES AND OFFERINGS

(Questions 39–59)

39. Question: What is the meaning of tithing?

Answer: It is the giving of one tenth (1/10) of our money to God.

40. Q: Where is the general law (rule) of the tithe found in the Bible?

A: In Leviticus 27:32b, "...the tenth shall be holy unto the Lord."

41. Q: Did tithing take place before the law was made?

A: Yes. Abraham gave a tenth and paid his tithe to Melchisedec before the law was given.

42. Q: What part of \$1.00 would be tithe?

A: Tithe is 1/10 of \$1.00; therefore, 10¢ belongs to God.

43. Q: With what kind of an attitude should we tithe?

A: With an attitude of worship, with love and cheerfulness, Psalm 96:8, "Give unto the Lord the glory due unto his name: bring an offering, and come into his courts."

44. Q: Is it possible to rob God?

A: Yes. By not paying our tithe. "Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me (God). But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings." Malachi 3:8.

45. Q: To whom does our tithe belong?

A: It belongs to God and His work.

46. Q: Did Jesus ever speak of "giving tithes?"

A: No. He said "Ye tithe" and "Ye pay tithes". He did not speak of giving tithes because tithes belong to God. Matthew 23:23; Luke 11:42.

47. Q: What are we to do with our tithe?

A: We are to bring it to the storehouse (the church). "Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house..."

48. Q: What is the meaning of the word "storehouse"?

A: The storehouse is our church, the place we are taught from the Bible and where we worship God.

49. Q: When do we bring our tithe to the church?

A: The first day of the week which is Sunday.

50. Q: For what is the tithe to be used?

A: It is used to take care of church needs and to support its ministry.

51. Q: What has God promised to those who pay their tithe?

A: He has promised to bless those who pay their tithe.

52. Q: What are the blessings God promised to those who pay their tithes?

A: "Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the Lord of Hosts, if I will not open the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it." Malachi 3:10.

53. Q: Should we give more than our tithe to God and His work?

A: Yes, we should also give offering (love gifts) to God and His work.

54. Q: What are some of the causes to which we give offerings?

A: 1) To missions both in our own country and foreign; 2) Gospel radio programs; 3) Sunday school; 4) Crusaders; 5) To the church; 6) To evangelists and other good causes.

55. Q: What did Jesus say about "giving?"

A: "It is more blessed (or enjoyable) to give than to receive." Acts 20:35.

56. Q: What kind of a giver does God love?
 A: **A cheerful giver. "For God loveth a cheerful giver." II Corinthians 9:7.**
57. Q: Who should give of the tithes and offerings?
 A: **Everyone, both children and adults should cheerfully give of their tithes and offerings.**
58. Q: What is one way a member can support the church?
 A: **A member can support the church by the giving of his tithes and offerings.**
59. Q: How do missionary offerings help the missionaries?
 A: **Missionary offerings provide money for transportation, for schooling of their children and pays for their needs.**



The Foursquare Gospel

(Questions 60–87)

60. Question: Who was the founder of the International Church of the Foursquare Gospel?

Answer: **Aimee Semple McPherson**

61. Q: Besides founding the Foursquare Church, what other great works did God help Mrs. McPherson to do?

A: **She founded Angelus Temple, L.I.F.E. Bible College, a radio station, an organization known as Crusaders and established Foursquare World Missions in many different countries.**

62. Q: What were some of the things she wrote?

A: **She wrote many books, published several magazines, wrote words and music for several sacred operas and composed many songs.**

63. Q: When did the Foursquare movement start?

A: **As Mrs. McPherson was preaching in a revival meeting in Oakland, California, in the summer of 1921.**

64. Q: What was Mrs. McPherson's sermon topic when preaching in Oakland, California, in 1921?

A: **Ezekiel's Vision---Ezekiel 1:4–10.**

65. Q: What one verse of this passage of Scripture, Ezekiel 1:4–10, was impressed upon Mrs. McPherson?

A: **"As for the likeness of their faces, they four had the face of a man, and the face of a lion on the right side: and they four had the face of an ox in the left side: they four also had the face of an eagle." Ezekiel 1:10.**

66. Q: What did the four faces mentioned in Ezekiel 1:10 resemble?

A: **The four faces resembled the four-fold ministry of the Lord Jesus as Saviour, Baptizer with the Holy Spirit, the Great Physician, and soon coming King.**

67. Q: What did the face of the man in Ezekiel's vision resemble?

A: **Jesus Christ as the Saviour of the world, "A man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief." Isaiah 53:3.**

68. Q: What did the face of the lion in Ezekiel's vision resemble?

A: **The Mighty Baptizer with the Holy Ghost.**

69. Q: What did the face of the ox in Ezekiel's vision resemble?

A: **The Great Physician --- "Himself took our infirmities and bare our sicknesses." Matthew 8:17.**

70. Q: What did the face of the eagle in Ezekiel's vision resemble?

A: **The soon coming King.**

71. Q: Is the name foursquare in the Bible?

A: **Yes, it is used many times. Six times in Exodus, once in I Kings, twice in Ezekiel, and once in Revelation.**

72. Q: Is the Foursquare doctrine (belief) based on the Bible?

A: **Yes.**

73. Q: Do we accept any doctrines (beliefs) aside from the Bible?

A: **No, we do not. The Bible is what we believe to be God's Word.**

74. Q: What are the four principal teachings of our Foursquare church?

A: **Jesus Christ is the Saviour, the Healer, the Baptizer with the Holy Spirit, and the soon coming King.**

75. Q: Which Bible writer presents the Lord Jesus as the son of man or Saviour?

A: **Luke.**

76. Q: Which Bible writer presents Christ as the Great Physician or Healer?
A: **Mark.**
77. Q: Which Bible writer presents Christ as the "lion of the tribe of Judah" or the Baptizer with the Holy Spirit.
A: **John.**
78. Q: Which Bible writer presents Christ as the "King" soon to come again?
A: **Matthew.**
