





Dear Teacher,

The *iNyaniso Student Activity Pages* are designed to reinforce your Bible teaching and help the students translate learning into action. In addition, the *iNyaniso Student Activity Pages* are also a tool to be used by parents to extend Bible learning into the home. Give parents a copy of the Welcome letter overleaf at the beginning of the year, or as new students join your class. This will assist them in making the best use of the *iNyaniso Student Activity Pages* at home.

Each local church needs to buy only one *iNyaniso Student Activity Pages Resource Book*. You may make photocopies of the *Pages* for your students as you need them. However, you may only make copies if your local church bought the book, and you can only copy from the original book. You may not make copies of pages already photocopied.

► Search the Scriptures on page 1 gi es additional Scriptures to e read y the amily. These erses gi e more insight into what the Bi le says on the lesson topic. You can read the Scriptures and answer the uestions a ter supper, at edtime, or at a once a wee Family Night Together. E eryone in the amily, no matter how young or old, can participate in learning more a out what God's Word teaches.

► There will occasionally e a Family Builder acti ity on page 1. This may ha e some ad ice or parents, or an acti ity or game or the whole amily to en oy at home during the wee.

► The Bible story review on page 2 is completed y your child in class during the lesson.

The important thing is that the *iNyaniso Student Activity Pages* are not ust or your child to use in class. They can help your amily grow closer together as you study God's Word during the wee. Set aside time each wee to complete the activities and discussions suggested. We pray that you will ind the time richly ul illing.
