
MY BIBLE COLORING BOOK

How to Become a Member of God's Family

"GOD IS LOVE." 1 JOHN 4:8

God loves you so much He wants you to be a member of His family. He sent His Son, Jesus Christ, to die on the cross for your sin. Sin is all the wrong things people do—like stealing, cheating and telling lies. Because Jesus never sinned, He is the only one who could take the punishment for your sin.

"THE FATHER HAS SENT HIS SON TO BE THE SAVIOR OF THE WORLD." 1 JOHN 4:14

Are you sorry for your sin? Do you believe Jesus died to be your Savior? If you are sorry, and if you believe, God forgives you and accepts you into His family. As a child of God you receive God's gift of everlasting life.

This means God is with you now and forever.

"FOR GOD SO LOVED THE WORLD THAT HE GAVE HIS ONLY SON, THAT WHOEVER BELIEVES IN HIM SHALL NOT PERISH BUT HAVE ETERNAL LIFE." JOHN 3:16

Now you can grow as God's child. The Bible will help you know what God wants you to do. In prayer you can tell God how much you love Him. You can show by what you do that you love Jesus. Then others will know that you belong to God's family.

How to Live as God's Child

"TO ALL WHO RECEIVED HIM [JESUS], TO THOSE WHO BELIEVED IN HIS NAME, HE GAVE THE RIGHT TO BECOME CHILDREN OF GOD." JOHN 1:12

When you become God's child, you become a brand new person inside. God will help you want to do what He says. And he will help you DO it. He will help you OBEY His plan.

GOD'S CHILDREN LEARN GOD'S WORD

"I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you." Psalm 119:11

You can learn what God wants you to know by studying what God's Word says and by learning Bible verses that teach you how to live as God's child.

GOD'S CHILDREN OBEY

"Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right." Ephesians 6:1

God wants you to obey everyone who loves and takes care of you— parents, teachers, police officers, other leaders—and even baby-sitters!

GOD'S CHILDREN LOVE AND FORGIVE

"Love each other as I have loved you." John 15:12

"Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you." Ephesians 4:32
Jesus loves people. Loving people means caring how they feel and doing what makes others happy. Some people treated Jesus in very mean ways. And He forgave them and kept right on loving them.

GOD'S CHILDREN GIVE

"Give to the one who asks you, and do not turn away from the one who wants to borrow from you." Matthew 5:42

"God loves a cheerful giver." 2 Corinthians 9:7

God gives you so much to enjoy. He wants you to be a person who shares happily with others. God especially wants you to give your friendship to others and to share the good news about the Lord Jesus.
