- -Math: How big was Noah's Ark in metric measurement? If it rained for 40 days and 40 nights, how many hours did it rain?
- -Science: Why is it necessary for humans to consume food from all food groups? What animals could you have placed together on an Ark today (carnivore vs. herbivore)? What animals would have to be separated?
